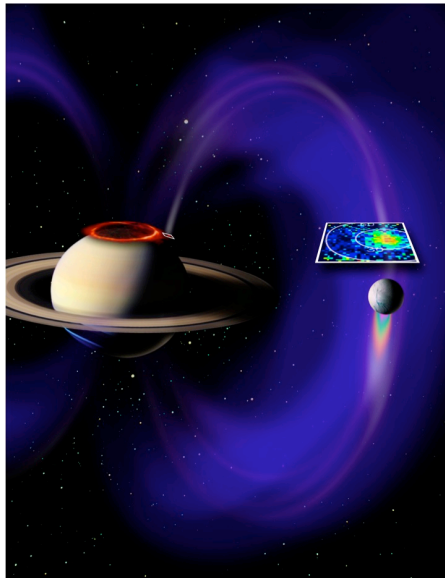
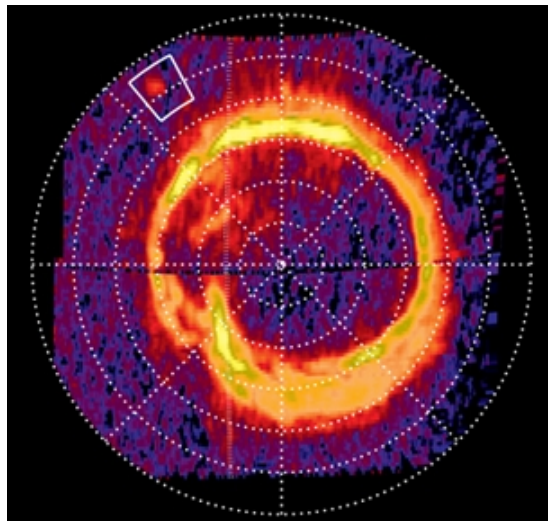


Saturn's moon leaves a "footprint"



- Enceladus, a moon of Saturn, is magnetically "connected" to the polar region of Saturn and leaves a footprint, as shown in this artist's conception.



- At left is an ultraviolet image from the Cassini spacecraft in orbit at Saturn.
- The Saturn aurorae ("northern lights") glow in an oval shape around the north pole, as shown in yellow-orange.
- Enceladus' footprint is the orange-red spot in the white box at the upper left.
